And then there's Ash Wednesday, which is the first of 40 days in the season of Lent. It's the day when ashes are placed on our foreheads to remind us that we are dust, and to dust we shall return. It's a solemn day, much like Good Friday. We repent of our sins, remember that the wages of sin is death, and return once again to the Lord who journeyed to the cross for our eternal life. You might call it a serious day.

So, how do you blend the sentimental with the serious? Do you feast or do you fast? I'm not sure. I'll let you figure that out on your own. But the word that these two days have in common is love. 1 John 4:19 says, "We love because He first loved us". The ashes placed on our foreheads are in the shape of a cross to remind us of God's sacrificial love for sinners. Jesus died for you because He loves you and wants to spend eternity with you. This is the greatest love of all. The love that we express to each other in greeting cards or in person are to reflect the unconditional love that God has for His Bride, the Church.

St. Valentine, by the way, was a man who was martyred (killed for his Christian faith) in Rome around 270 AD under Emperor Claudius II. It is said that the daughter of Valentine's jailer admired him. She was grieved that he was sentenced to death. Valentine wrote a small note of encouragement to her, assuring her that Christ's death and resurrection has conquered all our enemies. That's where the custom of passing out Valentine's Day notes got started.

I hope that you will take time to reflect on God's great love for you during this season of Lent. There are two great opportunities on Wednesdays (1 pm and 7 pm) to come to our special Lenten services. Each week we will "fix our eyes on Jesus" and marvel at His great love for us.

Eyes on Jesus: Our 2024 Theme for Lenten Midweek Services

O come, let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. (Gradual for Lent, based on Hebrews 12:2)

When the characters in the Passion narrative look at Jesus, what do they see? In most cases, people misunderstood who He is and what He was doing. In some cases, by faith, people recognized Him aright. Our Lenten series this year, based on the Gospel according to St. Mark, will examine how the various people around Jesus viewed Him—and how we should view Him. We will "fix our eyes" on what Jesus has done to save us from our sins by His holy, precious blood and innocent sufferings and death, and celebrate what God sees on account of His work: our justification for His sake.

Here is a look at our Lenten series. Please worship with us at either our 1 pm or 7 pm service. A Lenten meal will be served at 5:30 pm.

Feb. 14 (Ash Wednesday) "Misjudging Eyes"—Mark 14:1–9 The disciples misjudge Jesus' repeated predictions about His death. They can't see the anonymous woman's anointing of Jesus as preparation for His burial. But Jesus sees her beautiful deed that will be proclaimed throughout the world wherever the Gospel is heard. Feb. 21 "Betraying Eyes"—Mark 14:10–21, 32, 41–46 Judas betrays Jesus. Yet the behind-the-scenes reality is that Jesus was "handed over" by God the Father, so that Jesus could die for the sins of the world.

Feb. 28 "Sleepy Eyes"—**Mark 14:32–42** In Gethsemane, Jesus' inner circle of Peter, James, and John cannot keep their eyes open to watch and pray with Jesus for even an hour.

Mar. 6 "Denying Eyes"—Mark 14:26–31, 66–72 After Jesus is betrayed by Judas, ten of the disciples flee.
Peter, when spotted by a servant girl, denies Jesus, which leads to his own eyes weeping in remorse.
Mar. 13 "Murderous Eyes"—Mark 14:1–2, 53–65 The chief priests and scribes saw Jesus as an obstacle to be rid of by murdering Him through the Roman judicial system.

Mar. 20 "Worldly Eyes"—**Mark 15:1–20** Pontius Pilate can only view matters in a worldly, pragmatic way, wishing to placate the worldly Jewish leads and crowd, so he consents to handing Jesus over for crucifixion. The soldiers see the opposite of a worldly king, but their ironic hailing of Him as "King of the Jews" proclaims who He really is

Mar. 28 (**Maundy Thursday**) "More Than Meets the Eye"—**Mark 14:22–25** There is "More Than Meets the Eye" to the Lord's Supper. We will look into the Old Testament background of the Last Supper and rejoice in the mystery that Jesus, in and with, bread and wine, gives us His body and blood in order to deliver to us the benefits of His Passion.

Mar. 29 Good Friday "God's Eyes"—**Mark 15:21–39** We look through "God's Eyes" to see what is happening during the Passion: the once-for-all atonement for the sin of the whole world and the justification of all sinners on Easter.

Mar. 31 Easter Sunday "Angel Eyes"—**Mark 16:1–8** The angel in the tomb knows the whole story of Jesus' resurrection. When he sees the women, he proclaims the Gospel to them, shows them where Jesus' body had formerly lain, and tells them that they can see Jesus themselves in Galilee. Likewise, the "angels" or messengers of the Church tell God's people where they can find Jesus and His salvation in the Means of Grace.
